We continue to work on the suggestions received during our last Parent's convention. The result has been that attendance of our children has reached as high as 84% in the last quarter.

We were also able to recruit a speech therapist and psychologist, a gap which had existed ever since we reopened after the Covid period.

The most satisfying thing was that we received our FCRA renewal, putting Khushboo in a very select group of NGOs. This was a reaffirmation of the confidence of the government system in our governance process and the quality of our work.

The social sector continues to be under heavy scrutiny and our endeavour will be to have a high degree of compliance to the stated rules and regulations.

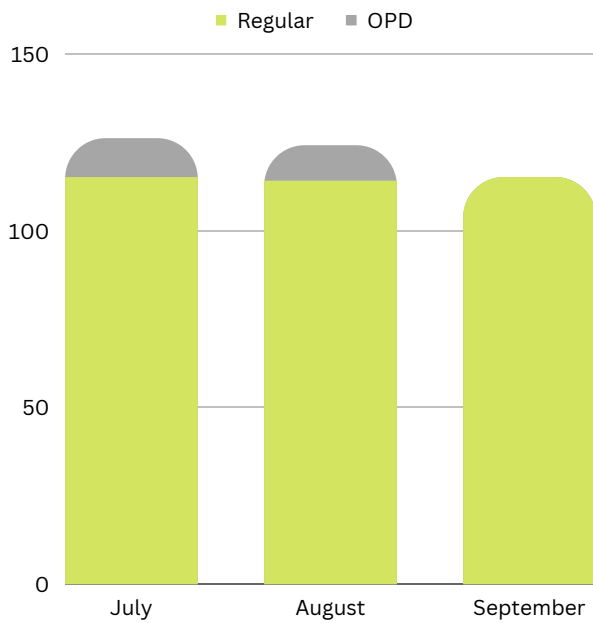
In these difficult times, we hope we will continue to get the support of our donors and well wishers.

I wish you and your family a very happy festive season.

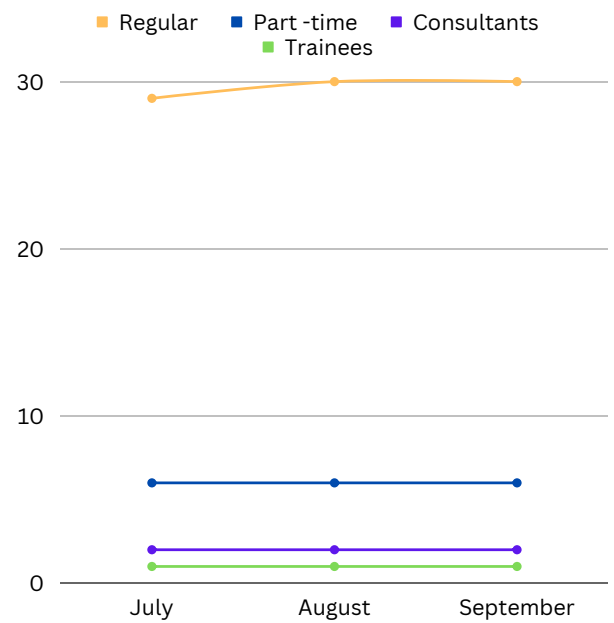

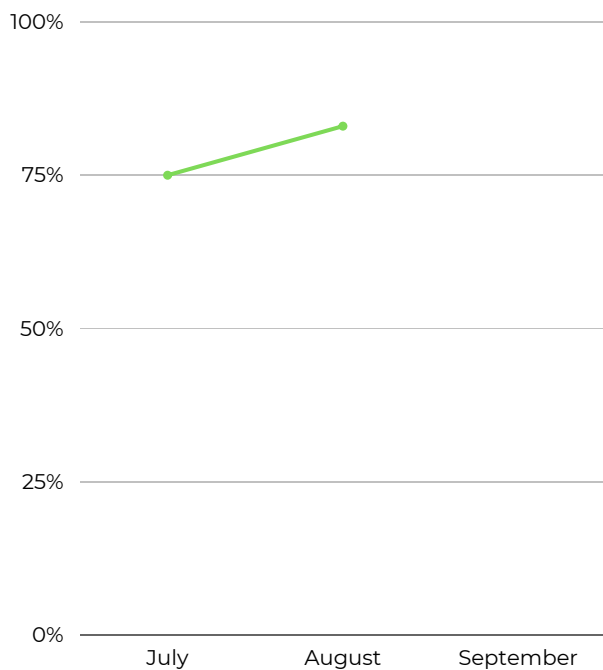
## NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES



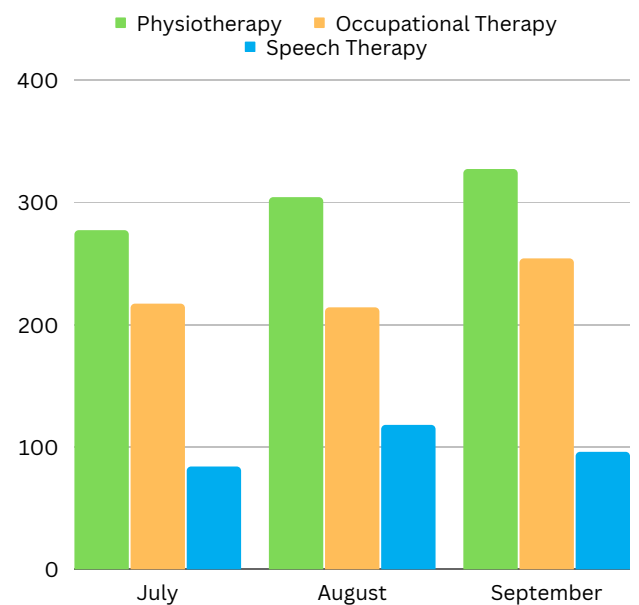
## NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES
