MESSAGE FROM PRESIDENT

Dear Friends,

Last quarter saw improvement on many fronts and reinforced the feeling that things were returning to what they were in the pre-Covid period.



First, the number of children under our care increased from 80 to 100 as many children had moved out during the Covid period. I'm confident that the number will keep rising in the coming days.

Second, we were able to fill the vacant positions in the staff especially those of special educator, Speech therapist, physiotherapist, and psychologist.

Normalcy returned in other ways too, with children participating in and celebrating various festivals like Independence Day, Raksha Bandhan, Janmashtami, and other events.

It was also fulfilling to see that parents were able to continue their means of livelihood as their children were taken care of at Khushboo.

However, the lingering effect of Covid continues to cast its shadow on fundraising, which faces many challenges.

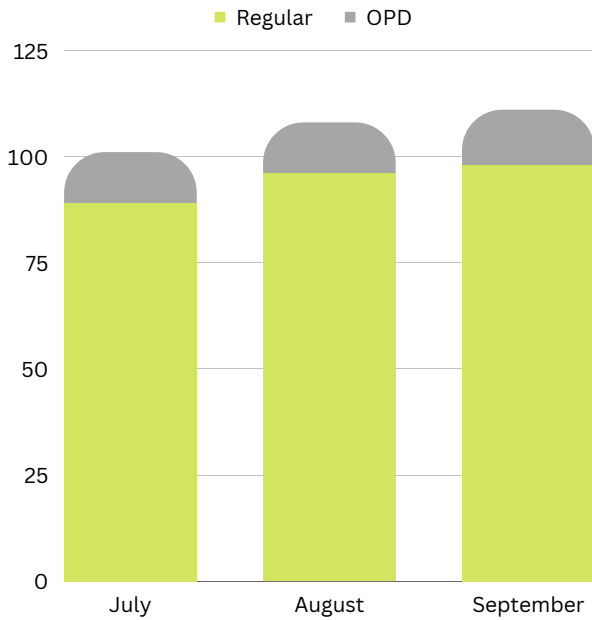
In such a situation, your support will help us tremendously to continue to look after the special children under our care.

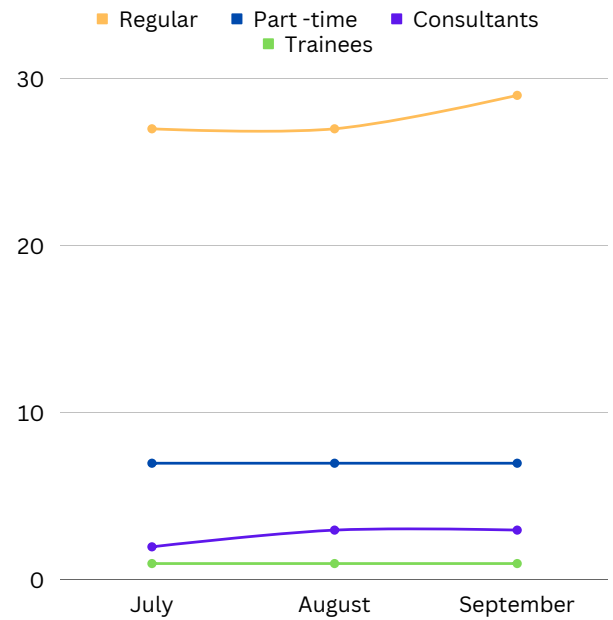

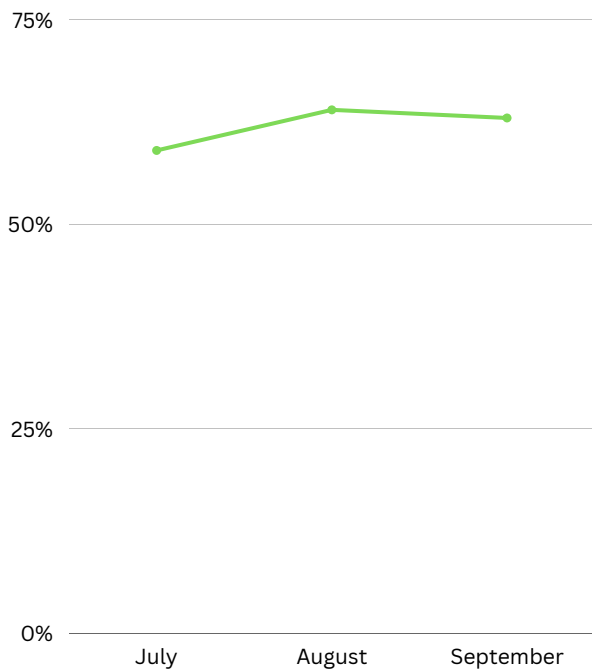
NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES



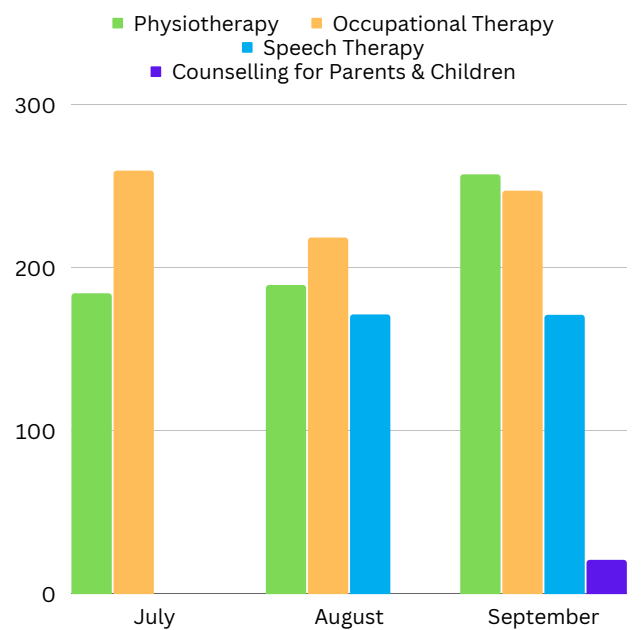
NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES
