
We look forward for your support to enable us to continue to look after special children at Khushboo's Day Care Center and also complete the construction of the Residential Facility.

#### February 15, 2022: Multimedia Workshop


A round table discussion was conducted on the Art and Design of books with AIMS Media, Delhi. The objective of having this meeting was to further the cause and add value addition to the existing program.
